PEEL PASSPORT COMPETITION ENTRY RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. THE PROMOTER

Peel Development Commission is referred to in this document as the "Promoter".

2. PARTICIPATION

The Entrant is responsible for insuring his or her familiarity with the Competition Entry Rules and Conditions at the time of participation.

3. ENTRY

Peel Passports containing the required Entry Form and are available in person from all Peel Region Visitor Centres and the WA Visitor Centre, Perth City.

The Entry Form must be stamped by five Visitor Centres (Boddington is pre-stamped).

The Entry Form must contain legible contact details

The completed Entry Form must be lodged at a PEEL Visitor Centre by 3pm, Friday 29 January 2010.

The Peel Passport Competition is open to all visitors to, and residents of, the Peel Region with the exception of the Promoter's employees or their spouse, de facto spouse, parent, natural or adopted child, and sibling.

4. PRIZES

- a) Prizes will be drawn on Radio 97.3 Coast FM at 4:00pm Monday, 01 February 2010 and prize winners notified on air, or if not available by later telephone and also by mail.
