

International Airfares and domestic transportation Matrix for Approved Employers under the SWP restart

This document provides Approved Employers with the maximum One-Way International Airfare and domestic transportation and Return International Airfare and domestic transportation amounts for the purposes of Schedule 3 of the SWP Deed of Variation.

Note: For Airfares to bring in workers under a special state/territory government quarantine agreement where workers quarantine on arrival in a state/territory prior to travelling to a different state to take up work (eg. Tasmania and Victoria agreement) Approved Employers may use the quarantine state or the work state maximum airfare. For example, if a Samoan worker travels to Tasmania to quarantine under a special agreement and then immediately moves to Victoria for work, the maximum cost that may be applied is \$750 as that is the higher cost.
